- Check that residents are claiming all the benefits they are entitled to
 - We can help with income calculations to make sure you are claiming all the different types of benefits you are entitled to
- Assist with new benefit applications and change of circumstance notifications
- Provide advice on changes to benefits

This includes Universal Credit, Personal Independence Payments (PIP), Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) and Pension Credit

- Advice regarding the Benefit Cap
- Mandatory Reconsideration (applications for when benefits are stopped or changed)
- Benefit decision appeals
- Advice regarding Carers Allowance and Attendance Allowance
- Signposting for help with debt problems and money advice
